TREASURER'S REPORT: Treasurer Lewis presented the May 2021 treasurer's report to the board for approval. Trustee Patterson made a motion to accept the report as presented to the board. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Clerk Grider presented the May 13, 2021 Regular Board Meeting minutes for approval. Trustee Patterson made a motion to approve the minutes. Trustee Pippin seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

APPROVAL OF PAYMENTS: Clerk Grider presented the unpaid bills to the board for approval. Trustee Holloway made a motion to approve the unpaid bills as presented to the board. Trustee Patterson seconded the motion. Vote taken; motion carried. Roll call – Branson - Aye, Holloway – Aye, Mann – Aye, Patterson – Aye, Pippin – Aye, Nay – 0.

VISITORS: Trevor Jarvis addressed the board voicing his concerns over chickens and defecating dogs. Attorney Rabin suggested putting the matter on the ballot as a public referendum. It was agreed that it would be difficult to police the dogs and their owners.

OLD BUSINESS: Extending Market open hours to 2 a.m. on Friday, Saturdays and special occasions. Patterson said he would get a list of what the special occasions would be.

NEW BUSINESS: Ordinance annexing land to the village: Rabin will look further into it. Tabled.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

PARKS – Trustee Patterson said mulch was needed. Dillion Assistant Chief of Police said he would get a price. Patterson also mentioned a root that needs to be removed.

STREETS DEPARTMENT – Trustee Pippin reported that work on the culvert on Main Street had been done and speed limit signs are in place. He said some sidewalk work may need to be done.

POLICE DEPARTMENT – Assistant Chief Dillion stated the month of May was a normal month for the department. He reported that the county fair will pay for assistance of two officers. He submitted the Police Report to the board, which is on file at the Clerk's office.

PERMITS – Trustee Mann stated there is nothing to report.

DELINQUENT BILLS – Nothing to report.

WATER/SEWER DEPARTMENT – Trustee Holloway reported that both revenues and expenditures were down this past year.

PUBLIC SAFETY – Nothing to report.

With no further business at hand, Trustee Holloway made a motion to adjourn the regular meeting; Trustee Patterson seconded. All in favor, motion carried.
